## **UQRCS Student Research Tipsheet**

- To complete the form you need the project title, synopsis, at least three student learning outcomes and any expected pre-requisite skills you would like the student to have. See an example below:

## **Project title:**

A systematic review of factors that influence consumer involvement in rural health practice, research and education.

# **Project synopsis:**

There is an increasing push to involve patients and consumers (i.e., patient, carer, family) in healthcare. This systematic review will examine the international evidence on consumer involvement in rural health practice, education and research. It will follow the PRISMA guidelines. #### **Student learning outcomes:**

Participation in this research will enable students to achieve the following learning outcomes:

- 1. Learn to undertake systematic searching of the literature.
- 2. Apply the PRISMA guidelines in practice.
- 3. Collaborative working skills.

## Pre-requisite skills:

It is desirable for students participating in this research to have undertaken literature reviews and to have a demonstrated ability to work with others towards a common goal.
